What is it ERA-NET Cofund under Horizon 2020...





ERA-NET Cofund under H2020 ...

ERA-NET Cofund under Horizon 2020 is designed to support public-public partnerships, including joint programming initiatives between Member States, in their preparation, establishment of networking structures, design, implementation and coordination of joint activities as well as Union topping-up of a trans-national call for proposals...





The difference between FP7 and Horizon 2020

It is based on the merger of the former ERA-NET and ERA-NET Plus actions and is implemented by using 'programme co-fund actions'

ERA-NET
Coordination of programmes

- MS agree and fund joint calls/programmes
- EU funding only for coordination

ERA-NET Plus: Top up of a single joint call

- MS contribute to a joint trans-national
- EU funding for research: ≤ 33% of the joint call

The structure was addressed at:



The regions that included can be participate at ERA-Net through the ESIF found, a good example is Region Calabria in M-**ERA-NET**






Non-EU Regions with Encoded R&I Priorities




